

**MINUTES FOR THE REGULAR CITY COUNCIL MEETING  
SEPTEMBER 9, 2024**

Bellevue City Council met on Monday, September 9, 2024, at 7:30 p.m. Following the Pledge of Allegiance, a prayer was offered by Council member, Mrs. Ommert. Council members present: MR. BAKER, MR. HILL, MS. MUNIZ, MRS. OMMERT, MR. SHEPHERD, and MR. WYNBISSINGER. Mr. Burkhart was excused.
