

MINUTES FOR THE REGULAR CITY COUNCIL MEETING September 8, 2025

Bellevue City Council met on Monday, September 8, at 7:30 p.m. Following the Pledge of Allegiance, a prayer was offered by Pastor and Council President, Ronald Smith. Council members present: MS. MUNIZ, MRS. OMMERT, MR. SHEPHERD and MR. WYNBISSINGER. Mr. Baker, Mr. Burkhart, and Mr. Hill were excused.

Minutes of the regular City Council meeting of August 25, 2025 were presented for approval. A motion was made by Ms. Muniz to approve the minutes as written. It was seconded by Mrs. Ommert. All were in favor. The minutes are approved as written.

REPORTS AND COMMUNICATIONS FROM CITY OFFICIALS:

Mayor Strecker welcomed Vickie Dauch, who was filling in for Clerk Rhonda Soper. Mayor Strecker announced that he heard from Andrea at the Willows and the annual Trunk or Treat will be held on October 9 from 1:30 - 3:00 p.m. for the seniors. There will be food and entertainment.

The Fall into Fall Festival is coming up. On 9/11/25 there will be a ceremony for 911 at 9:40 a.m. at the Fallen Soldiers.

Safety-Service Director, Mr. Brugnone, stated that the construction is still going on but everything is going smooth.

Auditor, Mr. Smith passed out a report of the year-to-date receipts and expenses. He pointed out the balance for the Street Fund. Mr. Smith commented on the Sandusky County Alternative (new proposed Alternative) Method of Funds. We could amend a resolution or do another one.

Law Director David Wallingford stated that there are not enough Council members present to pass the legislation tonight so Resolution R-8-25 will have its second reading only.
